

Have you ever had a moment when something you've seen many times suddenly looks different? Perhaps it's a familiar Scripture passage, a quiet moment in prayer, or a simple act of kindness that reveals God's presence in a new way. Lent often brings those moments. It invites us to pause, reflect, and allow Christ to open our eyes to the deeper meaning of our faith.

Now that we are in the middle of Lent, we are also currently celebrating the Scrutinies with our OCIA catechumens (those preparing to receive the Sacraments of Initiation at Easter). The Scrutinies are special prayers of the Church that ask God to strengthen what is good within them and gently heal what needs grace. While these rites focus on the catechumens, they also remind each of us that faith is a lifelong journey of conversion and renewal.

The Lenten season invites all of us into that same process. Through prayer, fasting, and acts of charity, we take time to reflect on our lives and allow God to shape our hearts more fully.

This weekend's Gospel beautifully reflects that message. Jesus restores sight to a man born blind, reminding us that true vision comes from encountering Him. Lent is an opportunity for Christ to open our eyes as well, to see Him more clearly in our daily lives, our families, and our parish community.

As a parish family, please keep our catechumens in your prayers during this important stage of their journey of faith. Their path toward the Easter sacraments is a powerful witness that can renew our own commitment to Christ.

During these Lenten days, consider praying together as a family, attending Mass faithfully, and reaching out to someone in need. Small acts of faith can open our hearts in powerful ways.

May this holy season draw us all closer to Christ. Blessings to you and your families!
