



The Gift of a Giving Community

When I look at the life of our parish, I see something truly extraordinary: a community that gives—consistently, quietly, generously, and with an open heart. And this giving is measured not only in donations, but in time, compassion, presence, and the willingness to serve wherever there is a need.

I see volunteers whose quiet service touches every corner of our parish. Our Eucharistic Ministers carry the healing presence of Christ to the homebound and to nursing home residents who cannot be with us at mass. Others offer their time and expertise at our liturgies, in the parish office, at the school, and wherever hands are needed. Some show up faithfully for Food Box distribution or make weekly trips to Second Harvest; others look after elderly neighbors or respond to needs before anyone even asks. These acts of love—often unseen, always heartfelt—form the quiet heartbeat of our parish, offered not for praise but out of genuine compassion and faith.

This spirit of generosity becomes especially visible in seasons like Thanksgiving and Christmas. Parishioners and school families worked together to gather food and coats for our community. Our students have embraced service with joyful enthusiasm, leading novenas that inspired gifts for nursing home residents, toys for Sacred Heart Community Services, and layette items for local mothers and babies. Our Giving Tree outreach was another volunteer operation: together we donated, sorted, and delivered toys and essential items for farmworker families. This came to life in a child’s smile hugging their chosen toy—an unforgettable reminder of how deeply our giving matters.

All this is because of **you**—your generosity, your compassion, your willingness to give from the heart. Like St. Martin of Tours, who shared his cloak with a stranger in need, you are clothing, comforting, and caring for those around you. Your acts of kindness echo the same spirit of charity St. Martin embodied, revealing Christ’s love in simple yet powerful ways.

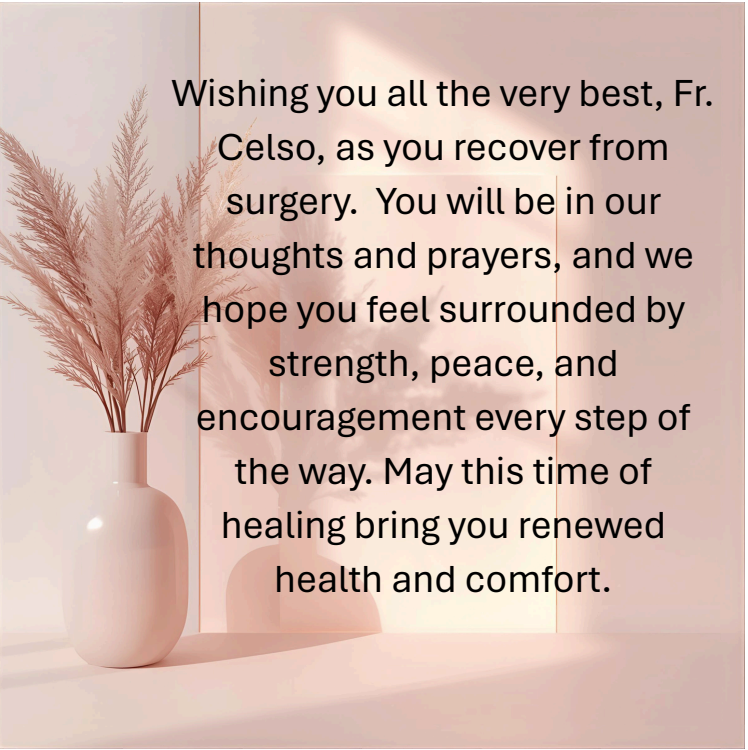
