Dear Parishioners,

When we pause to reflect on our daily lives, we naturally take pride in what we have accomplished. We look at the fruits of our labor, our careers, our homes, our talents, and the financial security we have gathered through our hard work and perseverance. It is true that we work tirelessly to cultivate our skills and acquire precious possessions. Yet, behind all our human effort lies an essential truth that we sometimes fail to recognize; everything we possess in this temporal world ultimately comes from the One who created us, our Almighty God.

Our time, our talents, and our treasures are not self-generated. Their ultimate origin is divine.
