Tiny Habits, Big Grace: A Night of Faith, Family, and Prayer at St. Martin of Tours

What a beautiful evening we shared at our Faith Night: Tiny Habits of Prayer! From the warm welcome at the door to the joyful hum of conversation over pizza, salad, ice cream, and even a glass of wine, it was a night filled with connection. Families enjoyed unhurried conversations, children had fun with food and activities, longtime friends reconnected, and many met new friends for the first time. The night truly felt like a living portrait of our parish family gathered in faith.

Fr. Brendan McGuire offered a simple but powerful reminder: prayer grows when we begin with small, meaningful steps. Even something as ordinary as pausing with our morning coffee can become a moment of prayer. These tiny practices help us gently build a steady rhythm of connection with God. Through reflection questions and the calming “Nine Breaths Prayer,” he encouraged us to see prayer not as one more task, but as an invitation woven naturally into daily life.

Our kids had a meaningful night as well. Middle schoolers enjoyed games and thoughtful conversation, while our youngest children learned about prayer as simple, loving conversation with God through stories, active play, and crafts. The night beautifully reflected the heart of the Diocese of San Jose Pastoral Plan - strengthening discipleship, nurturing family life, and building a welcoming community where all ages grow together in faith.

A heartfelt thank you to all families and parishioners who joined us, and a special thank you to everyone who gave their time, talent, and effort to make this evening possible. Your generosity brought this Faith Night to life! Mark your calendars—Part 2 of Faith Night returns on January 21, where we’ll continue our journey of deepening prayer together as a parish community.

All Souls Day 2025

We will host an In Loving Memory table behind the baptismal font in commemoration of all the Faithful Departed. All Souls' Day is a sacred time to remember our loved ones who have died and to pray for their eternal peace. You are invited to bring framed or unframed photos of your loved ones to be placed on the All Souls' Altar. Prior to All Souls' Day, a basket will be available in the church foyer where you may drop off your photos. Alternatively, you may place them directly on the altar after the All Souls' Day Masses.



Please include the name of the deceased and your name on the back of each photo. The pictures will remain on display throughout the month of November and can be retrieved during the first week of December.
