Walking with Christ: Finding Jesus on Our Road to Emmaus

Have you ever had a moment when something beautiful was happening right in front of you, but you didn't recognize it until later? Maybe it was a kind gesture, a quiet blessing, or even the presence of God in an ordinary day. The Gospel this weekend, the Road to Emmaus (Luke 24:13-35), invites us into that very experience.

Two disciples walk away from Jerusalem, weighed down by confusion and disappointment after the events of Good Friday. Along the road, Jesus Himself joins them, yet they do not recognize Him. It is only later, in the breaking of the bread, that their eyes are opened. This powerful story reminds us that Christ walks with us even when we feel lost, discouraged, or unsure.

As we continue through the Easter season, this Gospel carries a message of hope and renewal. The Resurrection is not just a past event, it is a living reality. Jesus meets us where we are: in our conversations, our struggles, and even our doubts. Like the disciples, we are invited to recognize Him in Scripture, in the Eucharist, and in one another.

This message is especially meaningful in Faith Formation, particularly for our children. Teaching them to see God in everyday life through prayer, kindness, and community, helps them grow in a living, active faith. It reminds all of us that faith is not only learned but experienced.

This week, consider taking time as a family to reflect on where you may have encountered Christ in your daily life. Share those moments, pray together, and remain open to His presence.

May your hearts burn with His love this Easter season, and may you recognize Him walking beside you always!
