The Transfiguration of Jesus

As we move into the 2nd week of Lent, I encourage you to read the bulletin and check the website for all the ways you can participate this year including Stations of the Cross, Adoration, Reconciliation, the next Community Faith Night, and the new Youth Mass on Sunday evenings.

Today's gospel highlights Jesus' Transfiguration on a mountaintop before Peter, James, and John. His face shone brightly like the sun, and his clothes became dazzling white, offering a glimpse of his glory and foreshadowing his resurrection.

The Transfiguration story appears in Matthew, Mark, and Luke, each account happening about a week after Jesus first told his disciples he would go to Jerusalem, suffer at the hands of religious leaders, be killed, and rise again on the third day. The disciples expressed disbelief, but Jesus doubled down, saying, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it," foreshadowing the martyrdom most of the disciples would later face.

An important detail often missed in the Transfiguration story is the presence of Moses and the prophet Elijah. Moses signifies the law given to Israel, while Elijah represents the prophetic tradition. Their appearance alongside Jesus bridges the Old and New Covenants, highlighting Jesus's role in fulfilling both and establishing a new covenant. Their presence likely had a profound impact on Peter, James, and John – offering fresh insight into the mystery unfolding before them.

Imagine you were there with the disciples after such a dramatic week. Perhaps you, too, would have echoed Peter's words on the mountaintop: "Lord, it is good that we are here."
