

Program Details

- Who:** Potty-trained children ages 2 through Kindergarten
- Where:** Community Building
- Format:** Children are placed in small, mixed-age groups and rotate through engaging activity centers such as:
 - Faith-based lessons
 - Crafts
 - Action & movement activities

Program Fee: \$30 per child

Parent Participation (Co-Op Model)
The Sunday Preschool Program operates as a **Parent Participation Co-Op**. Each family is asked to have at least one **parent volunteer on a rotating basis**. We warmly welcome participation from both parents whenever possible.

- Online Safe Environment (Virtus) training
