



My Dear Parishioners,

Greetings of peace as we journey this sacred season of Advent!

Advent comes from the Latin word, "adventus," which means "coming." This time of waiting beautifully calls us to remember and anticipate two great comings: the joyful celebration of Jesus' First Coming His birth in Bethlehem 2,000 years ago and the anticipation of His Second Coming, known as the Parousia.

As we navigate the world, we are naturally tempted to focus only on material preparation: decorating our homes, shopping for gifts, and filling our calendars. - 3.Y Yourself Last: Trust that God will care for you when you serve Him and others.

When we live this message, we truly enliven the message of Jesus' coming into the world. As the angels sing, "Joy to the world, the Lord has come!"

May peace and joy of Jesus' presence fill your homes and your hearts throughout this holy season.
