Focusing on the Youth of our Community

Middle school and High school are such crucial times in the lives of our youth, and for me, this is personal. Years ago, My daughters loved the Middle School EDGE program, and were so excited to join the High School LifeTeen group, but it was canceled. I experienced my daughters being challenged by the complexities of high school, and the struggles of being a teenager in a world plagued by loneliness, desperation, and a need for connection other than through their phones. Without a ministry here, they became untethered from both God and the comforting and familiar parish community they called home for 10 years.

Is it no surprise then, when many of our 8th Graders, and their parents, move on from our school community, they also leave our parish?

This is a huge missing link in the chain of our community, and our parish cannot be a vibrant community without a flourishing presence of youth.

Mr. Cortese rekindled the Middle School Ministry during Advent. He expected maybe 5 kids at the first evening; 26 middle schoolers showed up. That number grew to 32 the following week, which that is why the program has been extended into January.

Tonight we take a big step to rebuild a vibrant and thriving youth ministry essential to the success of our parish revival. Starting on Sunday February 22, and continuing for the six weeks of Lent, through Sunday March 29th, we are re-instituting a 5:00 pm Sunday Night Youth Mass, with Middle School Ministry immediately following Mass.

All parishioners, but especially any and all middle school, high school, and college age students are warmly invited to join us. Our music leaders will be the heartfelt and engaging Brian Yoshi and Angelo. Father Francis Kalaw, the beloved Chaplain at Archbishop Mitty High School has committed to help us as much as he can by celebrating Masses and delivering a relevant message for our youth.

This Sunday night Lenten Mass is also an option for families not able to attend Sunday morning Masses because of other commitments.

Introducing a Sunday night Mass is a significant investment of limited parish resources, so while our goal is to make it a permanent feature of our parish, we must first measure the willingness of our community to support this effort during the 6 weeks of Lent.

This May, 37 more 8th graders will join the ranks of many of you gathered here tonight as proud Bengal alumni. A successful Sunday Night Lenten Mass series gives us the ability to welcome those newest Bengal alumni, and many more, to our permanent Sunday Night Mass and High School Ministry this fall.

As much as it seems he can, Mr. Cortese can't do it all! So we are asking for your support of this youth ministry as well as all of the ministries of our parish.
