Magnifica Humanitas: A Historic Encyclical for Our Times



What Happened

On **Monday, May 25, 2026**, Pope Leo XIV personally presented his first encyclical letter, *Magnifica Humanitas: On Safeguarding the Human Person in the Time of Artificial Intelligence*, at an historic event in the Vatican's Synod Hall, attended by cardinals, theologians, and technology leaders. This marks the first time a papal encyclical has been publicly presented by the pope himself.

The teaching document, addressed to "all people of good will," was **signed by Pope Leo XIV on May 15, 2026**, the 135th anniversary of Pope Leo XIII's landmark, *Rerum Novarum*. Just as his predecessor addressed the Industrial Revolution and workers' rights in 1891, Pope Leo XIV is responding to the "new things" of our age: artificial intelligence, algorithmic power, digital inequality, and the future of the human person.

Reflection on Magnifica Humanitas by Bishop Cantú

"Magnifica Humanitas does not ask us to fear artificial intelligence. It asks us to be wise about it. The use of such powerful technologies has the ability to do tremendous good in favor of humanity and yet to also cause irreparable damage to individuals, communities, and societies. It calls us back to what we already know: that the common good matters more than efficiency, that human dignity cannot be optimized away."

Sharing the Good News!

If you've ever attended or watched a sporting event, particularly when a field goal or extra point is kicked, you've probably seen a sign in the audience saying John 3:16.

In today's Gospel we heard this passage: "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life."

What is the significance? This verse is an example of what is often called the first proclamation of the Gospel—or Kerygma (Greek for "proclamation" or "announcement"). Simply put, the Kerygma is the core message of the Gospel.

But how can we effectively share it with others in our everyday lives?

1. Start with Prayer

It largely begins by praying for those you are walking with, asking for the Holy Spirit to guide your conversations.

2. Build a Genuine Connection

Build authentic relationships. Take time to understand where the other person is coming from—their joys and hopes, as well as their griefs and anxieties.

3. Share your Experience

Share your experience of God's love and how your faith has impacted your life.

4. Introduce them to our Community

The early Christians "devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer" (Acts 2:42). Their faith was formed in community—and ours is, too.

This week, I invite you to begin praying for and building a genuine connection with someone you may like to introduce to the St. Martin's community someday. It could be someone new or perhaps someone that has been away for a while.

As summer begins, it's also great time to add a Catholic book to your reading list—especially one that helps you learn more about the faith.
