The Living Water We All Need

If you have ever been on a road trip, you would understand that you can't just keep moving, you have to stop at some point to gas up, use the rest room, eat, drink some water or simply just stretch your legs. This is what the season of Lent offers us in a way. We are on a spiritual journey and we pause during Lent to look at the very basics of this journey. It is a holy season of grace and so we are immensely blessed during this time as it is very evident in the readings at Mass for this weekend.

None of us would ever doubt the importance of water in our lives. About 70% of the human body is made up of water and we know how thirsty we can get if we go without water for just a couple of hours a day. The personal encounter the Samaritan woman had with Jesus reveals a lot of things in our spiritual life. She's in need of water, but she really thinks it's the physical water at the well that she needs. The water she truly needs is the person of Jesus in her life.

This classical biblical story is the story of each one of us who in our search for the "Living Water" mistakenly go to the wrong wells to fill ourselves up only to realize after some time that we have been at the wrong well all along. This is symbolized by our attachments to pleasure, power, wealth, and honor. The true water that can quench our thirst is the one that Jesus offers. This water is found not at physical well but in the word of God and in the sacraments that nourish us daily. During this Lenten Season of grace, may we approach Jesus the Living Water that He may offer us His Water in our personal encounters with Him.
