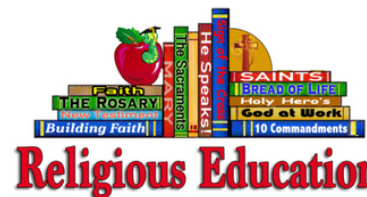

Serving with a Humble Heart

The first reading from Sirach (part of the Wisdom literature in the Hebrew scriptures) emphasizes the importance of conducting oneself with humility. It further notes that the greater one’s position, the more essential it is to act modestly to earn genuine respect and favor, both among people and before God.

While these are certainly good reasons for being humble, as Christians, the most important reason is because the infinite God, the creator of all, humbled himself in becoming human and suffering an ignominious death, sharing in our humanity. Another poignant moment was when Jesus washed his disciples’ feet as recorded in the Gospel of John prior to the Last Supper, providing an example of humility and service.

Jesus consistently encouraged his followers to practice humility, and by virtue of our baptism, all of us as disciples of Christ are likewise called to embrace this attitude. In the parable of the wedding feast, for instance, Jesus advises choosing the lowest place when selecting a seat, underscoring the principle that “everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted.”

This week, let us actively seek to cultivate humility and serve others, following Christ’s example.
